AirPangaea Challenge (4 weeks)

Group Discussion

Step 1: Get to know each other

The first step of the team project must be "Get to know each other". That would be the best way to proceed with the team project efficiently and enjoyably. Let's join "Group Discussion" on your left and talk with your new friends from different cultures!

Task: After brief self-introduction, let's play the following games together.
Target duration: 3 days

- Share your hometown**
Let's take a couple of pictures for your town and post them on Group Discussion. Your team members from other country will definitely enjoy it!
- Find 4 things in common**
You need to find at least 4 things in common in your team. It could be, common interest, favorite artist, age, gender, family structure, alphabet in common in your names, what you experienced in your childhood, etc.
- Virtual scavenger hunt**
You need to post at least 2 pictures of household goods or items nearby that fit following descriptions:
 - Something that's traditional in your country (food, cloth, building etc.)
 - Something that's close/related to team members' country or region
 - Something that reminds you of your childhood
